

MOTOR BOAT LONGER THEN 12 FEET?!



NEW LEGISLATION REQUIRES
ALL MOTOR BOAT OPERATORS BORN
AFTER December 31, 1958 to have the

NJ Boating Safety Certificate
by June 1st or face a fine of
\$500 for first offense!

Course concludes with test and, a “temporary” Safety certificate with passing grade. “Official” license to follow in about 8 weeks. This course also certifies 13 to 15 year olds to operate a craft 12' with up to a 10hp motor, and qualifies them for the “NJ Boating Safety Certificate” upon turning 16.
