

2017 NBYC SUNDAY SERIES

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The series will consist of 7 races. The scheduled dates are **July 2nd, July 9th, July 16th, July 23rd, August 6th, August 20th and August 27th**. **No races will be held on July 30th or August 14th**. **Mid-Bay Championship:** Three of the Sunday Series races for adults will count towards the Mid-Bay Championship, **July 9th** (NBYC hosts), **July 23rd** (SAYC will host) and **August 20th** (LYC will host, Auxiliaries will race between NBYC & SAYC). Each of these three races will be scored both for NBYC Sunday Series and separately for the Mid-Bay Championship. **Registration for the season:** A boat must sail in at least 5 of the scheduled races in order to qualify for end of season awards. If 6 or 7 races are sailed, the 5 best finishes will be scored. **If 5 or fewer races** are sailed, all races will be scored. Registration for the season is \$40; single day \$10 per boat.
2. Races will be scored in accordance with the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix A.
3. Auxiliaries will be scored under the PHRF handicap formula. All Auxiliaries **should present a new or renewed PHRF certificate for the 2017 season.**
4. Sanderlings and Sandpipers will sail together and will be scored using the Portsmouth handicap formula.
5. No race shall be considered official unless at least 2 boats of each class come to the starting line.
6. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat in its class finishes will be scored DNF.
7. Radios may be used to report Did Not Start, Did Not Finish, Retiring from Race or any other emergency.
8. The races will be abandoned when the wind speeds exceeds **15MPH for Sanderlings and Sandpipers; 18MPH for Auxiliaries.**
9. Since the 420 is a team boat, the 2 sailors must stay the same all season. However, the Skipper and Crew can be interchangeable. Any changes to the sailors must be approved by the Race Committee.. All Club 420s must comply with the Jr BBYRA safety requirements.
10. All decisions will be made by the Race Committee and will be considered official and final
11. All Skippers are required to check in with the Registration Desk each Sunday, including all Junior Sailors

12. Weekly awards will be made as follows:

Adults

Auxiliaries

2 boats competing – 1st Place Flag and Rooster

3 boats competing – 1st and 2nd Place Flags

4 or more boats competing – 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Flags

Sanderlings and Sandpipers

A Rooster and 1st place pennant will be awarded to the winner of the combined race. Depending upon the number of boats in each class pennants will be awarded as follows:

2 boats in the class, the 1st place boat will receive a 1st place pennant. 3 boats in the class, a 1st and 2nd place pennant will be awarded. 4 or more boats in the class, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place pennants will be awarded.

Juniors

2 boats competing – 1st and 2nd Place Flags

3 or more boats competing – 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Flags

13. Season Ending Awards will be made as following:

Adults

2 Qualifiers 1st place award

3 Qualifiers 1st and 2nd place awards

4 or more Qualifiers 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards

Juniors

2 Qualifiers 1st and 2nd place awards

3 or more Qualifiers 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards
